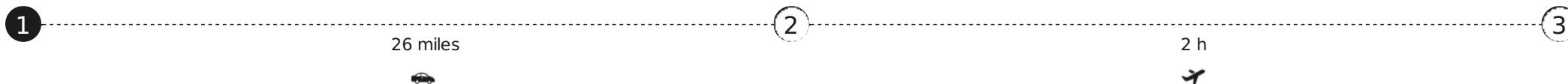

2 BEITOU — 3 NIGHTS

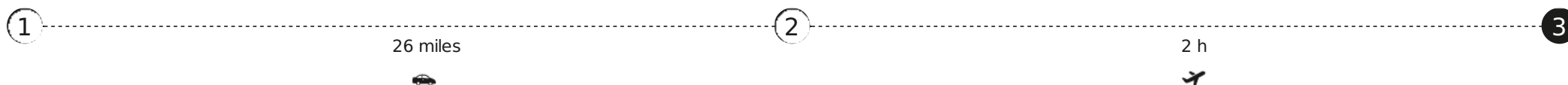
