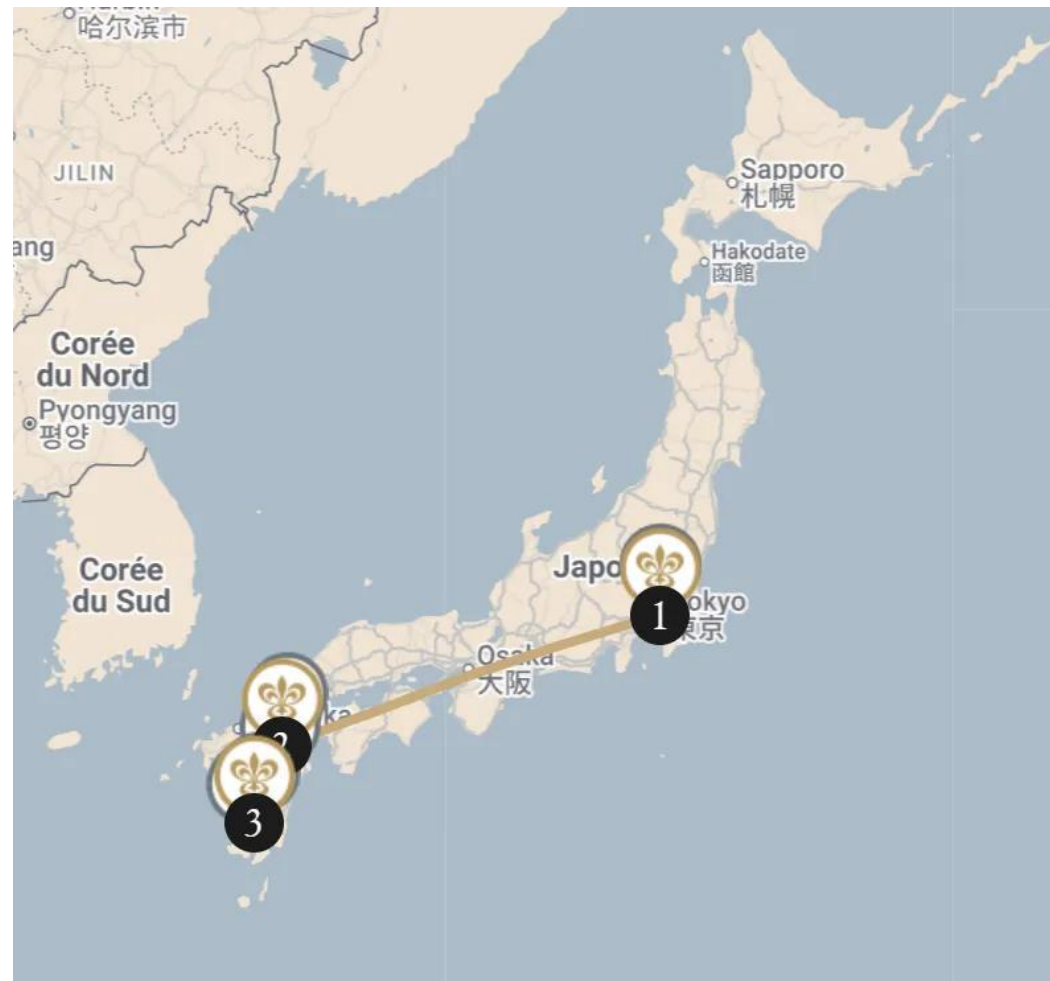




ROUTES DU BONHEUR From Tokyo to the volcanoes of Kagoshima, a side of Japan that's off the beaten track

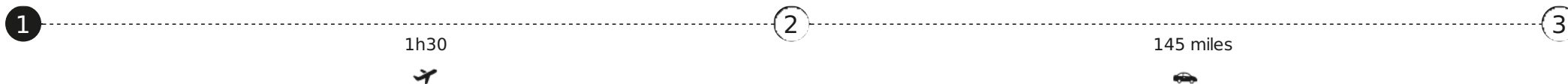

The Kitano Hotel Tokyo

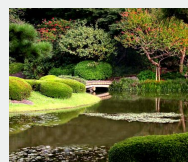

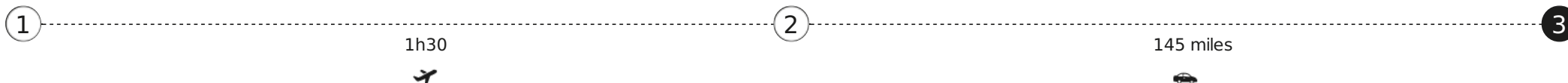

Hotel and restaurant in the woods. It is through reconnecting with nature that one's humanity can be discovered. Driven by his vision, the site's owner has spent over twenty years landscaping the woods and hills, excavating the hot springs, to give birth to this rare place. Set deep in the four seasons forest and overlooking the volcanic mountains of Kagoshima, a handful of discreet villas welcome those in search of serenity. Tranquility reigns, open air baths and spas soothe the body, and the spectacular view over Mount Kirishima calms the spirit. Rooted in its region, the restaurant serves original cuisine with seasonal vegetables from the garden and chickens raised on its own farm.
