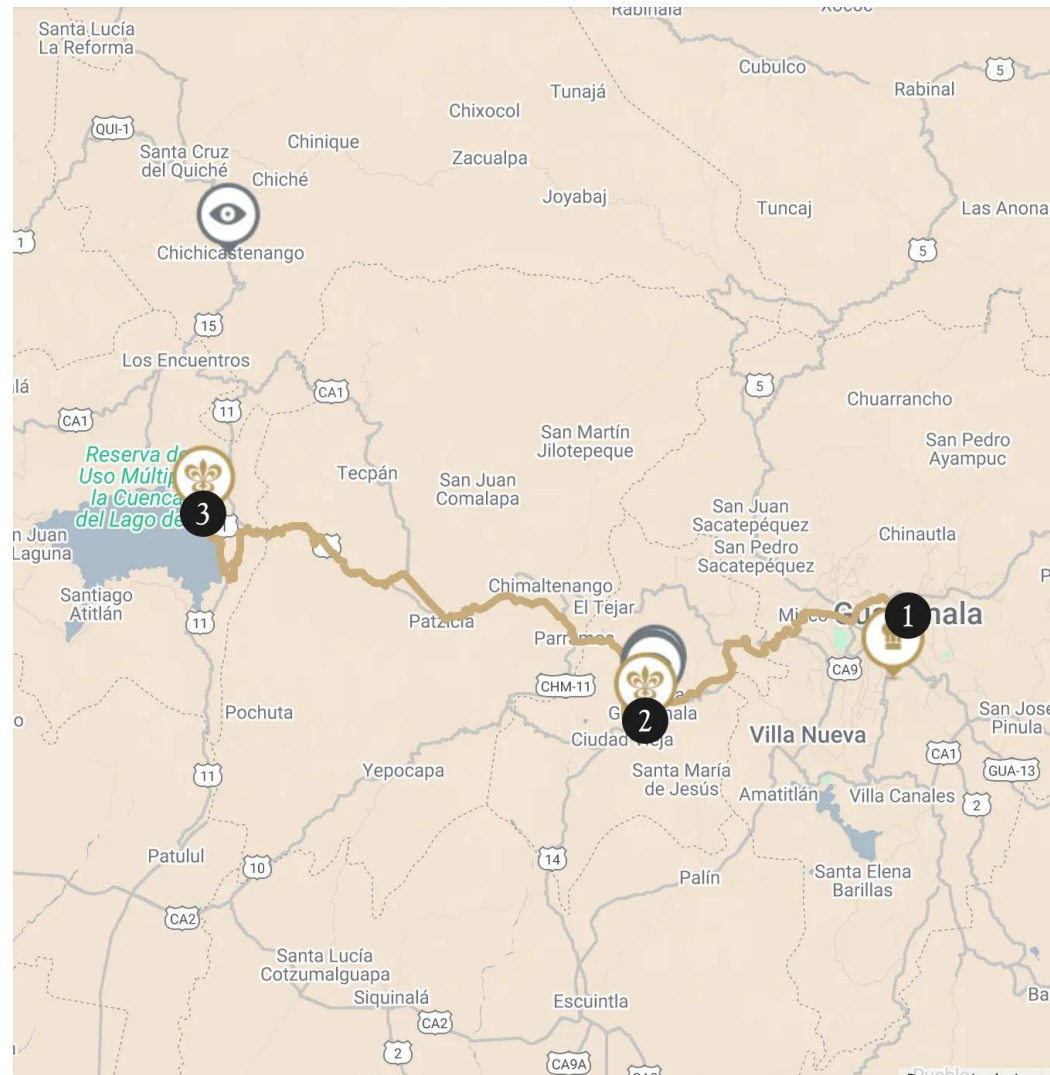


Guatemala

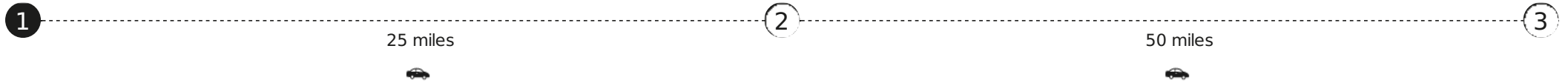

1 GUATEMALA CITY — 1 NIGHT

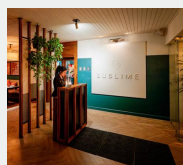
