Chalet Hotel Schöneegg

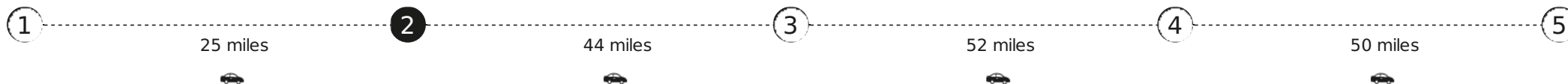
Hotel and restaurant in the mountains. With the Matterhorn towering overhead, there is no doubt that Chalet Hotel Schöneegg in Zermatt is truly located in the heart of the Swiss Alps. Some wines have been produced in the local area for more than four generations by the Metry family, owners of the hotel.

Walliserhof Grand-Hotel & Spa

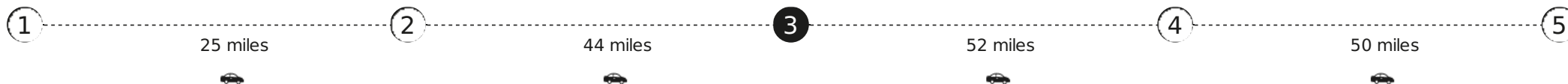

Hostellerie Du Pas de L'Ours

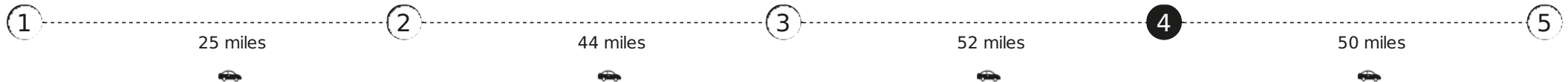

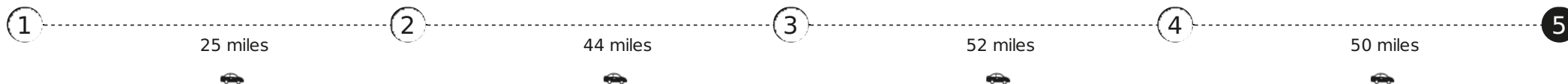
