




ROUTES DU BONHEUR A journey along the water, between the châteaux of the Loire Valley

1 ROMORANTIN-LANTHENAY — 2 NIGHTS

Grand Hôtel du Lion d'Or

Restaurant and hotel in town. Tucked away amidst the Loire châteaux in the Sologne region's capital of Romorantin, the town that inspired Leonardo da Vinci to visit France, this Renaissance-era mansion has been welcoming in visitors since 1774, and is now run by the Clément family. From the Renaissance wing to the Napoleon III balconies, the 16 bedrooms here are embellished with authentic old materials, mirrors, woodwork and flagstones, all fully renovated by Marie-Christine and Didier Clément. Chef Didier Clément pours his talent and artful touch into developing groundbreaking natural flavors in dishes designed to sit alongside an incredible wine list, in which the wines of the Loire Valley are given pride of place. A delectable moment to be savored.

Les Hauts de Loire

Restaurant and hotel in a park. Along the wine route, among approximately 3,000 chateaux that have led the region to be known as the 'Land of Kings', stands Les Hauts de Loire. A former hunting lodge built in 1860, this property is an idyllic refuge for couples, family or friends, less than three hours from Paris. Its elegant ivy-covered silhouette nestles in the heart of a remarkable 173-acre/70-hectare park, which invites exploration throughout the year. Relax at the spa while the children enjoy the kids' club, or set off together to discover the riches of the Loire region-the chateaux of Blois and Chambord are located just a short distance away. Like refined cocoons, the rooms and suites of the Les Hauts de Loire charm with their exposed beams and half-timbered walls. And to satisfy the appetites of young and old alike, the chef of the gourmet restaurant combines simplicity with sophistication is dishes using local, seasonal produce.

Les Hautes Roches



Château de Noirieux


