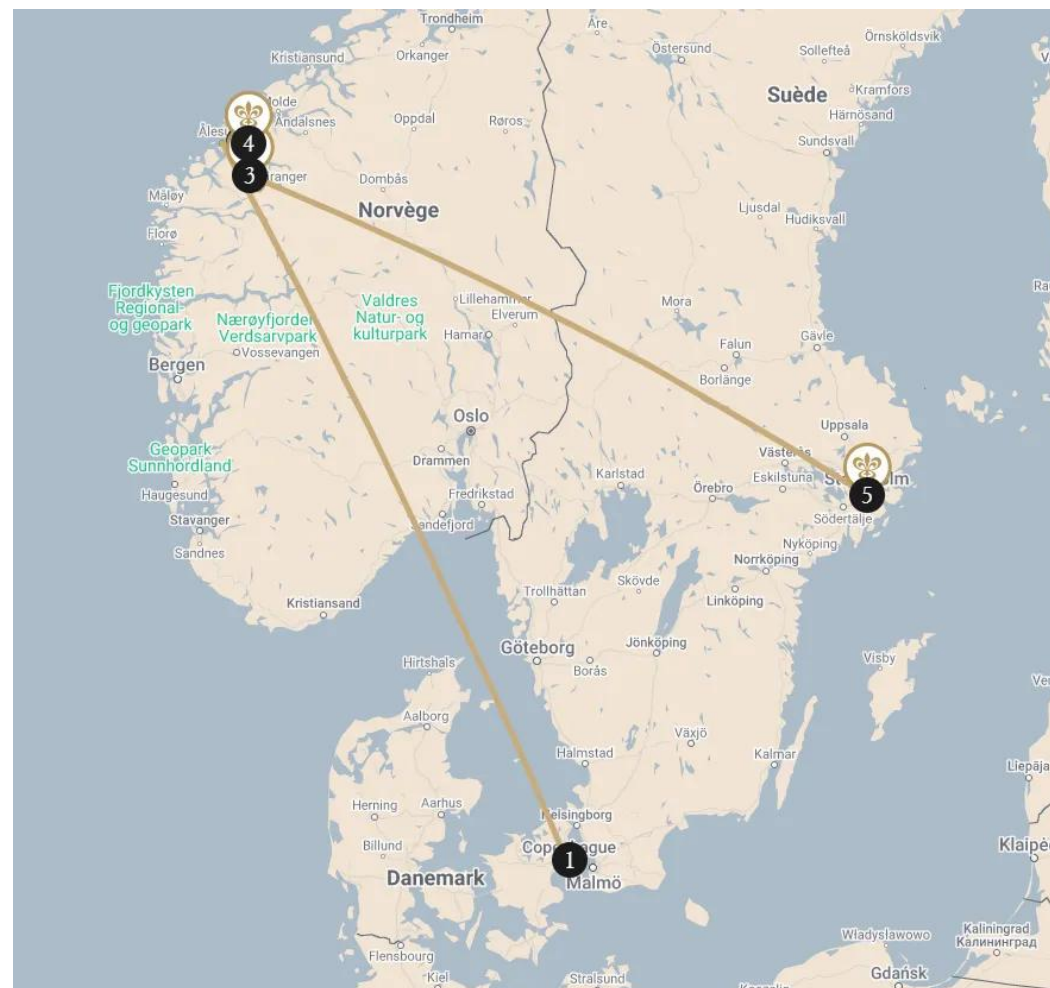

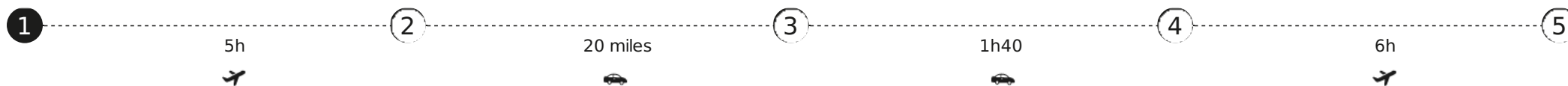

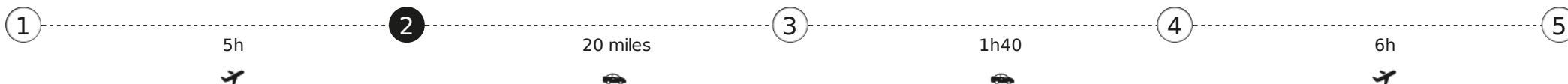

**2 ÅLESUND — 1 NIGHT**

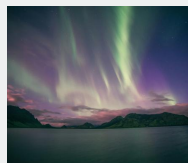

## Storfjord Hotel

This grand establishment of dark-timbered buildings, typical of traditional Norwegian architecture, is set upon a hill overlooking the fjord of the same name. Its log walls shelter warmly welcoming interiors: Comfortable furniture, antiques, and objets d'art create a chic, rustic ambiance in the living rooms and library, as well as in the rooms and suites blessed with spectacular views of the fjord and surrounding forest. Whatever the season, Storfjord offers an authentically Norwegian stay: skiing in wintertime, cruises and fishing trips on the fjord, kayaking adventures, scenic hikes, bike rides, Nordic wildlife observation, and, of course, relaxing moments at the wellness center with panoramic views of the landscape. Fine dining, too, is part of the experience, ensured by Florian Harnisch: This environmentally enlightened chef selects ingredients that are picked, fished, or aged within a few miles of the property. His expressive, down-to-earth cuisine reflects the rugged beauty of the region.

## Stockholm Stadshotell

Located in Södermalm, a fashionable district known for its boutiques and art galleries, Stockholm Stadshotell is the ideal place from which to soak up local life and explore the Swedish capital. It is housed in a magnificent 19th-century residence, listed as a national heritage site. Its owners, experts in renovation, art and design, have conceived an intimate and refined atmosphere, where décor combines soft tones, artisanal furniture and works of art. This identity is also expressed through photographic exhibitions curated by the resident artistic director. Traditional, locally inspired gourmet cuisine is served in the former chapel, while more informal dining can be found in the bistro and bar, whose tables overflow into the hotel courtyard. In the wellness area, you will find the essentials of Swedish spas, including a sauna, ice bath and sensory shower.

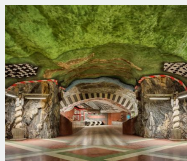
