




ROUTES DU BONHEUR Among the Douro valley vineyards

Deep in the Douro Valley, vineyards form geometric patterns that turn the countryside into a work of art. In this long-arid landscape, the inhabitants chose to devote their lives to wine. The quintas – the term for the region's wine estates – rise above the river on all sides, reached by breathtaking winding roads. Moving inland from the Atlantic coast, from Porto to Sabrosa, experience the intense emotions felt in exploring this region, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2001.



The Yeatman

Hotel and restaurant in town. Sit back on the terrace of your room and admire the panoramic view: beneath your eyes, Porto, a Unesco World Heritage site, and the sinuous curves of the Douro river. The Yeatman, located in the heart of Vila Nova de Gaia-the historical headquarters of the Port wine houses-owes its name to a family of British traders who are still active: this legacy is told through the décor of the rooms and a great collection of Portuguese wines. The chef showcases contemporary gastronomy, with food and wine pairing an important part of the dining experience. The final touch is the choice of treatments available at The Yeatman Wine Spa-an oasis of harmony and well-being.

Casa da Calçada

Hotel and restaurant in town. The lemon-yellow facade of the Casa da Calçada hints at the sunny stay that awaits at this hotel. Situated in the heart of the town of Amarante, between the bustle of Porto and the sundappled countryside of the Douro Valley, both less than an hour away, this building dating back to the 16th century, with its golden baroque interiors, is a favourite with those who love beauty, golf, great wine and gastronomy. Nearby you find a splendid 18-hole golf course. The hotel also produces "Vinho Verde" wines, and on-site activities include a tour of the region's best wine "quintas" that will ensure that you never forget the differences between Tawny, Ruby, White or Vintage Port.

Quinta Nova Winery House

Hotel and restaurant in a vineyard. Nestled in the heart of the Alto Douro wine region, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this intimate and deliciously bucolic hotel boasts breathtaking views of the Douro River and the surrounding hills of terraced vineyards. With over 120 hectares of land, Quinta Nova is also a renowned producer of succulent Port and Douro wines. Evoking the feel of a large family home, its quite and enchanting setting is perfect for tasting the joyous simplicity of Portuguese living. In the kitchen, chef André Carvalho honours local products as he revisits the region's traditional cuisine with finesse and nobility, while also matching his creations with exquisite wines.
