## ROUTES DU BONHEUR China and Japan, from island to island

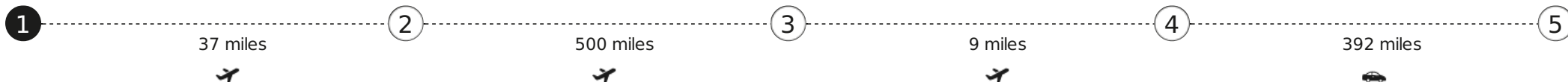

## Tate Dining Room & Bar

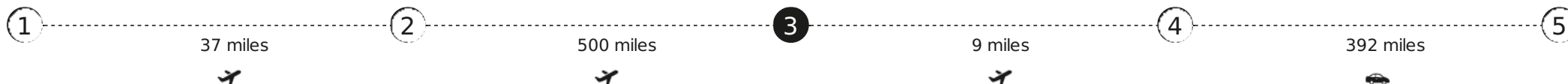

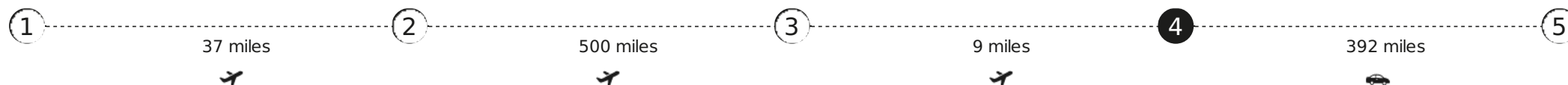

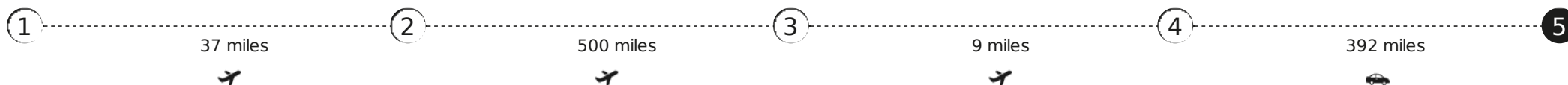

## Villa 32

**Hotel and restaurant in town.** It has been more than a century since the first hot springs hotel opened in Taiwan, and it became a destination thanks to the healing properties of the water.
