You’ll follow in the footsteps of Andersen's fairy tales and the paintings of the golden age of Danish art, as well as the small producers and great chefs who have brought local cuisine to the top tiers of the major dining guides.

1 COPENHAGEN — 2 NIGHTS

Founded in the 12th century, Copenhagen has been the capital of Denmark since 1416. Its present splendor owes much to Christian IV, a great admirer of the Renaissance. He had many of the buildings and castles you'll see while cycling around the city constructed in the 17th century. From the 19th century, Copenhagen established itself as a major cultural center, finally becoming a pioneering city in terms of urbanism and quality of life. In total, the city has 26 stars in the Michelin guide – an excellent start to any gastronomic exploration. A gourmet exploration of the Scandinavian capital of haute cuisine is a must.

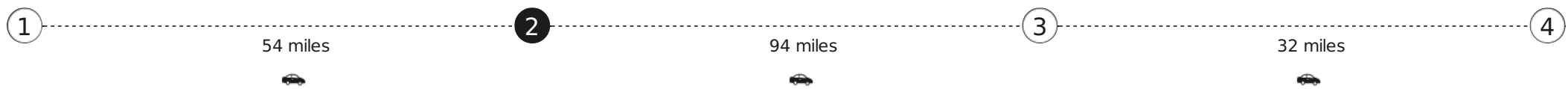

Dragsholm Slot

Hotel and restaurant in the country. For more than 800 years, Dragsholm Slot, a Danish castle that has weathered the test of time, has stood bathed in the exceptional light of the Odsherred Peninsula. It is surrounded by the shallow bays, woods and fields of a Unesco Geopark. The impressive landscape was created during the ice age, with lateral moraines and rolling hills surrounded by Denmark's finest beaches and criss-crossed by paths that provide breathtaking views. Inside the castle, discover an ambience of warmth and authenticity, an invitation to continue the experience in the gourmet restaurant. Under the wide, white stone arches, Nordic gourmet cuisine holds court, fostered by the area's exquisite, acclaimed produce.

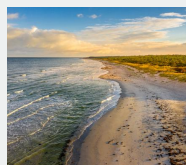

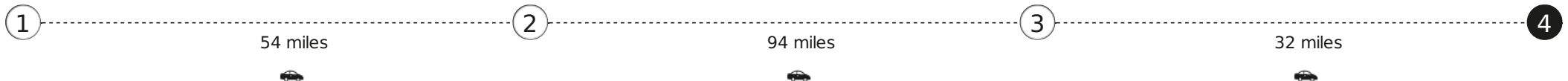
