





ROUTES DU BONHEUR From the Main to the Rhine -Legendary forests, rivers and vineyards

3 SAARBRUCKEN — 1 NIGHT

ESPLANADE Saarbrücken

Hotel and restaurant in town. In the border triangle between Germany, France, and Luxembourg, ESPLANADE Saarbrücken is located at the entrance to the Nauwieser Viertel quarter, the cultural center of Saarbrücken. The building that the hotel calls home is a former schoolhouse, dated circa 1890. This architectural gem, a historic landmark from the Wilhelminian era, now serves as an elegant retreat and an outstanding dining establishment. The common areas are masterpieces of natural light, harmonious hues, sleek lines, noble materials, and sensual fabrics. The restaurant's cuisine is every bit equal to the décor. Chef Silio Del Fabro always uses fresh regional market produce to compose his evolving selections. His dishes are interpretations of classic French haute cuisine with Mediterranean and Japanese influences, playing on the subtle contrasts between classicism and modernism. Among the many prestigious labels on the wine menu, pride of place is given little-known wines from the German terroir. Individually selected design classics and mid-century artworks adorn the tastefully decorated guest rooms at ESPLANADE Saarbrücken, while the attentive and efficient service adds to the unforgettable charm of your stay.

PURS Luxury Boutique Hotel & Restaurant


