




ROUTES DU BONHEUR From Versailles to the Loire Valley, a royal odyssey

Les Lumières


Hotel Les Lumières, located directly opposite Louis XIV's Palace of Versailles, is housed in two 17th-century pavilions given by the Sun King to Edouard Colbert and Antoine de Gramont. An historic building that combines well-chosen contemporary décor with the welcoming comfort of a private residence. The spacious rooms and suites bear the names of major figures from the Age of Enlightenment, who ensure that 21st-century travelers have the rest they require. Amid precious woods and streamlined furniture, La Table des Lumières is where chef Erwan Le Thomas serves creations born of culinary excellence and a deep love of the region. In the spa, the gentle rippling of the marble water walls mingles with the fragrance of treatment oils, promising guests many moments of pure well-being in a soothing, refined setting, all the more enjoyable after a private tour of the château arranged by the hotel concierge.

Fleur de Loire

Hotel and restaurant in town. This imposing 17th-century building, which stands on the left bank of the river in Blois, is home to the Fleur de Loire hotel. This welcoming property, designed in an eco-responsible way, is a true haven of tranquility. Just two hours from Paris, it is the ideal starting point to explore the region and the châteaux of the Loire in particular. At his gourmet restaurant and at the Amour Blanc restaurant, Chef Christophe Hay shares his passion for regional local products, which he serves with fruit and vegetables grown in his large vegetable garden. Guest rooms in the two wings of the building evoke the gentle way of life and verdant environment of the Loire Valley. Its contemporary decor has been inspired by the tones of the slow-moving river and its sandbanks. As well as the pleasures of the table, Fleur de Loire also offers profound relaxation in the serenity of its well-being area, with its indoor pool and signature plant-based aromatic treatments (closed for renovations, with a reopening planned for spring/summer 2026).

Château Louise de La Vallière

Hotel and restaurant in the country. A true marvel of the Loire Valley, situated between Tours and Amboise, Château Louise de La Vallière is an invitation to indulge in the delights of the senses and times of yore. Exuding the utmost refinement, the decor brilliantly bridges the gap between past and present, and is particularly impressive in the nine rooms and eleven suites. At the gourmet restaurant L'Amphitryon, enjoy the privilege of savouring a cuisine prepared with local and seasonal products, some of which come directly from the château's vegetable garden. During a romantic stay, why not partake in an unforgettable tasting session at the champagne bar Le Saint-Évremond or relax in the outdoor swimming pool, which is heated all year round? Combining a magnificent journey through time with a delicious caress for the senses, it is no wonder that such moments spent at Château Louise de La Vallière never cease to amaze.
