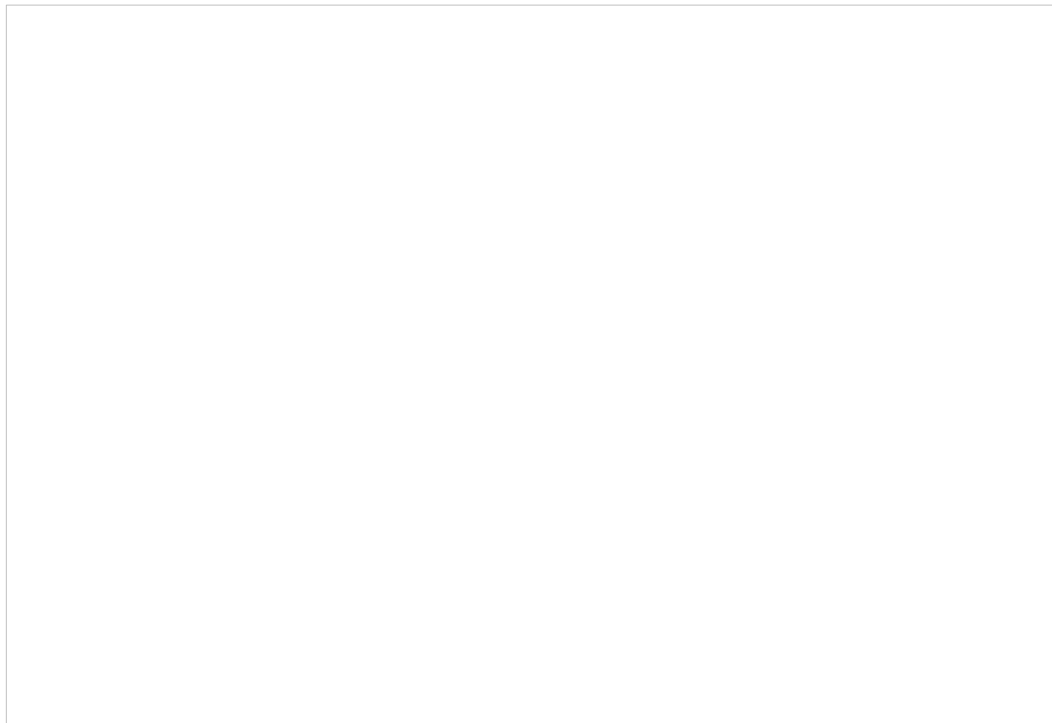

ROUTES DU BONHEUR Maine, Quebec and Ontario over lakes, rivers and waterfalls

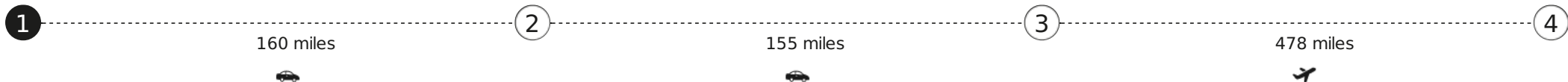
