
1 CASABLANCA — 2 NIGHTS

Hôtel Le Doge

Hotel and restaurant in town. In the heart of the Art Deco district of Casablanca, Le Doge is a gem of a hotel, where authenticity and sophistication are key. Legend has it that it was an Italian entrepreneur who gifted this little gem to his wife, who he met in Morocco. The building's 30s architecture is carried through in the interior décor and the conservation of central period elements. Le Jasmine restaurant's traditional Moroccan cuisine will delight all the senses. Much like the Petit Spa that offers treatments and rituals in the purest oriental tradition: steam baths with eucalyptus, argan oil massages and hammam all contribute to the relaxing well-being experience on offer in the heart of the 'White City'.

2 MEKNÈS — 1 NIGHT



Château Roslane

Hotel and restaurant in a vineyard. The first winery in North Africa to be listed as a château viticole for the quality of its wines, Château Roslane is also home to an intimate hotel encircled by luxuriant gardens. Blending contemporary decor with Spanish-Moorish architecture, the luminous rooms and suites are adorned with noble materials that invite complete relaxation. Each comes with a balcony or terrace overlooking the Middle Atlas Mountains, perfect for enjoying a breakfast replete with expansive views of vineyards and lavender fields. From the spa treatments featuring wine extracts to the entirely organic cuisine of the gourmet restaurant L'Oliveraie, the celebration of nature's richness is Château Roslane's true raison d'être.

Riad Fès

4 MARRAKESH — 2 NIGHTS

Villa des Orangers

Hotel and restaurant in town. Fine fabrics, exquisite furnishings and pillows embroidered with gold thread... the best of Moroccan craftsmanship has been used to furnish this palace. The moment you arrive, you know you are in for a treat. The private Riad suite has its own swimming pool and patio, where you can sip mint tea and taste Moroccan delicacies. Explore the large garden with patios full of plants; relax in its massage rooms and the Nuxe beauty salon; dine in the restaurant, which blends French, Mediterranean and Moroccan influences, then retire to the cigar cellar; and refresh yourself in one of three pools, of which two which are heated during cooler seasons and one on the rooftop overlooking the Koutoubia and the Atlas mountains. Palais Ronsard

Hotel and restaurant in town. Twenty minutes from the centre of Marrakech, discover Palais Ronsard, a haven of tranquility in the heart of the city's historic palm grove. Combining the charm of the Orient with colonial-inspired architecture, this hotel is built around two main pools surrounded by colonnaded galleries where you can stroll or enjoy your meals. Subtly designed by decorator Gil Dez, the twenty-two rooms and suites boast terraces and gardens that overlook a park where, among the century-old olive trees, roses and fountains, six private pavilions with swimming pools are also hidden.
