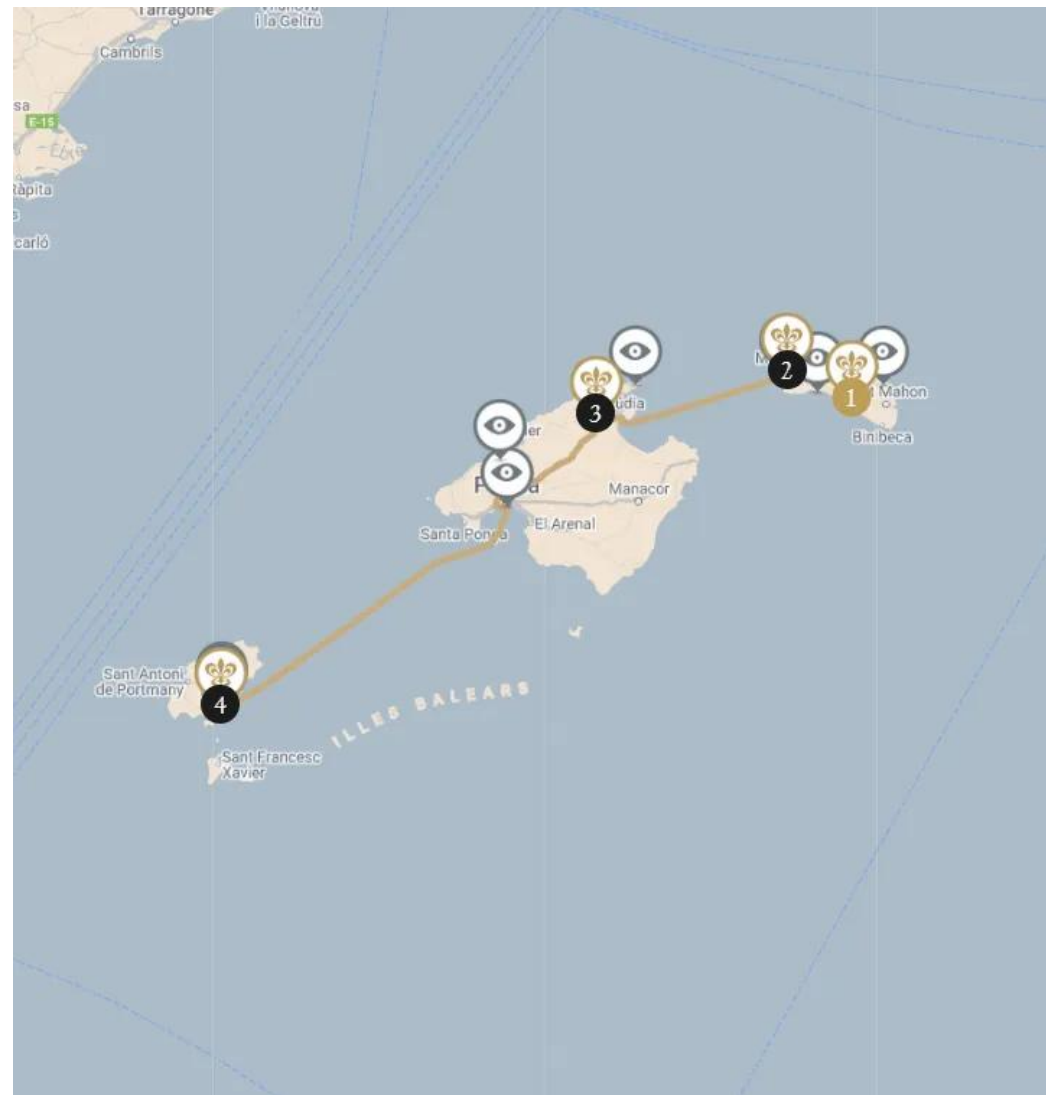

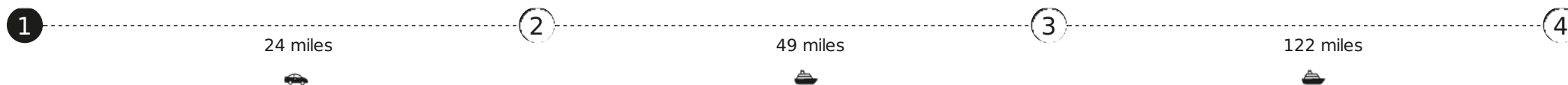

1 ALAIOR MENORCA — 2 NIGHTS

Fontenille Menorca - Torre Vella

Hotel and restaurant in the country. On the island of Menorca, owners Frédéric Biousse and Guillaume Foucher have embarked on a beautiful adventure by resurrecting two traditional Minorcan farmhouses from their ashes, which today compose the Fontenille Menorca. Nestled amidst a vineyard, aromatic plants, olive and citrus groves, and an organic permaculture garden, Torre Vella and Santa Ponsa, its sister property located a few kilometres away, now welcome visitors in search of authenticity. Decorated with natural materials in shades reminiscent of linen, sandstone and slate, the rooms and suites maintain their cool freshness, while the Mediterranean sun invites you to take refuge under the palm trees that line the pool and stand tall against the azure blue sky. With the sea as its backdrop, this beautiful setting is exactly what you have been yearning for.

Cap Menorca

On the southern Menorcan coast, high on a cliff overlooking the Mediterranean, Cap Menorca is surrounded by a 75-acre pine forest that has been transformed into grounds of lush tropical vegetation by more than 15,000 planted trees, shrubs, and flowers. Encircled by dry-stone walls, like the traditional Menorcan country homes called fincas, the suites are tucked away in gardens, each with a private swimming pool sheltered by century-old olive trees. The décor is elegant and simple: whitewashed walls, mahogany woodwork, verdigris tile in the bathrooms. A stay at Cap Menorca is made all the more memorable by the many experiences to choose from. The cuisine features Mediterranean flavors and is crafted with local, in-season ingredients. Meals are served in the hotel restaurant, but can be enjoyed beside your swimming pool for a tête-à-tête dinner. The spa offers relaxing massages either outside, where you can gaze upon the blue waters of the Mediterranean or in your suite. Yoga classes, as well, can be enjoyed outdoors. If you prefer to contemplate the coast from the open sea, set off on a sun-drenched cruise aboard one of the hotel yachts to discover secret coves and beaches of fine, soft sand.

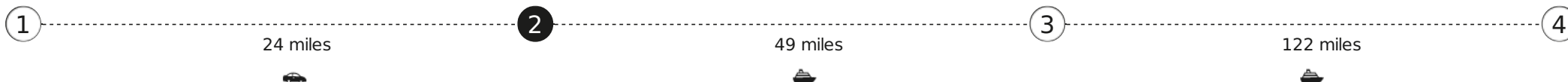

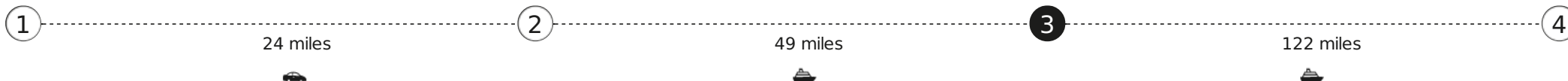

Son Brull Hotel & Spa

Hotel and restaurant in the country. In this former hillside monastery in Mallorca, asceticism lives on in the décor, where white walls shine forth against the deep blue sky. The spa is a water and teakwood paradise using essential oils derived from the island flora. The swimming pool, a chic camping ground, provides large white parasols to ensure deckchairs remain in the shade. The rooms offer views of the sea, the olive tree orchards and the bay of Pollença. Organic produce, including olive oil, wine, citrus fruits and vegetables, is cultivated on the grounds and served in the restaurant. There is little inclination to venture out of this pleasant hotel, unless it is to head for the beaches or the golf course.

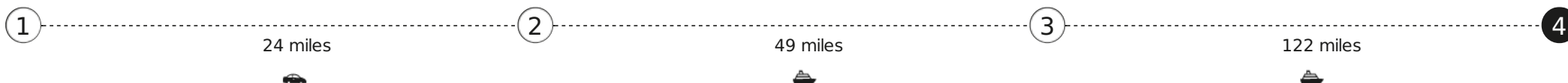

When it was converted into an intimate and welcoming hotel, none of its historical values were lost.
