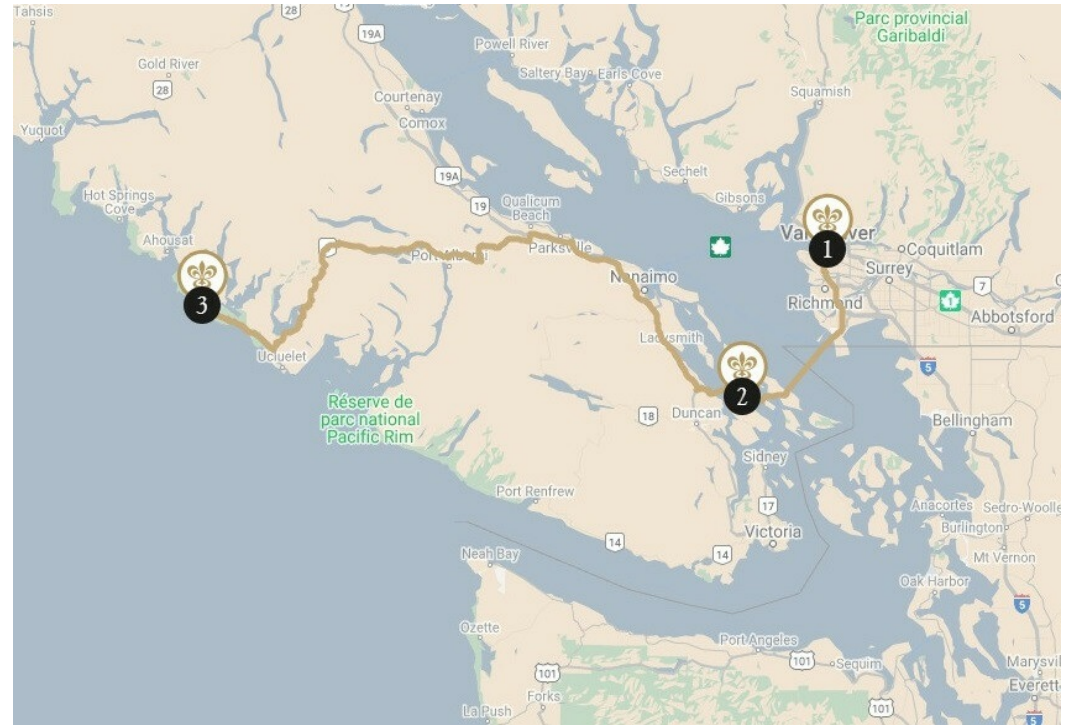

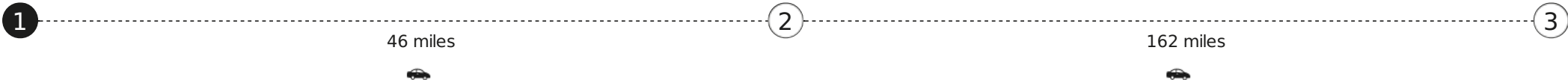

## Hastings House Country House Hotel

## Wickaninnish Inn

**Hotel and restaurant on the seafont.** The Wickaninnish Inn stands on an outcrop between the Pacific Ocean, Chesterman Beach and a forest of giant evergreens.
